LONG DAY'S JOURNEY INTO NIGHT Bi Gan | 2018 | 140 min. | NR

China's biggest ever art-house blockbuster, *Long Day's Journey into Night* follows lost-soul Luo Hongwu on a quest to find his long-departed love. Evoking the poetic romanticism of Wong Kar-wai, Bi Gan's atmospheric noir culminates in a hypnotic, 50-minute long-take.

THEY SHALL NOT GROW OLD Peter Jackson | 2019 | 132 min. | R

Crafted by Oscar-winning director Peter Jackson from meticulously restored, 100-year-old archival footage, blockbuster documentary *They Shall Not Grow Old* is a powerful and poignant tribute to the British troops of the First World War. A must-see for fans of *Apollo 11*.

AN ELEPHANT SITTING STILL Hu Bo | 2018 | 230 min. | NR

Named the year's best film by *Cinema Scope*, *An Elephant Sitting Still* is a staggering landmark of new Chinese cinema and a posthumous triumph for its young director, Hu Bo. Unfolding over the course of a single day, this deeply felt epic follows a group of outcasts in a northern Chinese town.
