Winner of the Olivier Award for Best Actress, the electrifying new production from playwright Suzie Miller and director Justin Martin (*Prima Facie*) stars Rosamund Pike (*Gone Girl*, *Saltburn*) as Jessica Parks—a successful judge and devoted parent whose carefully balanced life is upended by a crisis close to home.
